

Pacific Rim Sculptors (PRS)

PRS received nonprofit status at the end of 2016, a productive year for both the organization and members. For International Sculpture Day 2016, Lynne Todaro, Jann Nunn, Charles H. Stinson, and Al Honig hosted events throughout the Greater San Francisco Bay Area. 2017 events included a group exhibition in collaboration with Marin Society of Artists, open studios at San Francisco's 1890 Bryant Street Studios, sculpture tours at Sonoma State University, and more. In 2016, PRS member Zahava Sherez was visiting artist in sculpture/mixed media at the 360 Xochi Quetzal International Artist Residency Program in Mexico. Kate Ruddle was a textile artist-in-residence in Iceland, where she explored natural fabric dyes derived from native lichens. Cyrus Tilton won the 2016 John S.
